The launch of the Fund represents many months of hard work by the NYSNA NYCH+H/Mayorals Executive Council and Board of Trustees of the Fund. 
1. Summary Plan Description booklet;

Please be sure to read through each of the documents carefully and completely. Please also keep them for future reference. We would like to draw your attention to a few highlights of the new NYSNA Tuition and Continuing Education Fund and some important changes from the prior reimbursement guidelines.

- Unlike the prior reimbursement structure, pre-approval is no longer required to receive reimbursement.
- Claims must now be submitted within three (3) months of completion of the course/offering. This is a change from the previous guidelines that allowed six (6) months.
- The maximum annual reimbursement is \$5,200 for participants employed full time and \$2,600 for participants employed part time. This annual benefit amount is per fiscal year and the benefit amount will be revisited each year by the Trustees.

In closing, we look forward to participants taking full advantage of the new NYSNA Tuition and Continuing Education Fund. The benefits offered by the Fund will allow NYSNA nurses to continue to provide their patients and the City of New York with the highest-quality care possible.
