Learning Outcome:

Participants will be able to identify current standards of critical care nursing practice for the COVID 19 patient and apply them to selected patient conditions.

- Discuss the impact of stress on nursing practice during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Recognize the appropriate nursing assessments, findings, and interventions related to the respiratory status of COVID 19 patients, including mechanical ventilation in the critical care setting.
- Discuss the appropriate nursing assessments, findings, and basic assessment information related to the cardiovascular status of COVID 19 patients in the critical care setting.
- Apply the appropriate nursing assessments and interventions related to the COVID 19 patient who develops acute renal failure in the critical care setting.
- Discuss the latest information related to current medication and treatment, nursing management related to COVID 19 patients in the critical care setting.
- Discuss the appropriate nursing assessments and interventions related to patients requiring continuous veno venous hemofiltration with ECMO.
- Describe the long-term impact of COVID 19 on select body systems.
