Capture, Dilute, Exhaust: Ventilation to Protect Against Airborne Infectious Agents (SARS-CoV-2)

Learning Outcome(s):

Participants will identify two (2) best practices around the use of ventilation and AIIRs to reduce hazards associated with airborne infectious agent exposure in healthcare.

Objectives:

1. Recognize the role that ventilation can play as an environmental and occupational health hazard control in healthcare settings.
2. Differentiate between the different components of proper building ventilation in the healthcare setting.
3. Identify ventilation best practices related to the control of airborne infectious agents, particularly Sars-CoV-2.
4. Design strategies for advocating around improved ventilation in the event of a resurgence of COVID-19 case.
